1. All pigs participating in this show must have been raised or produced by a GA breeder who is a current member of the GA Bred Show Pig Association. Exhibitor's ages include pre-club through 21 years of age.
2. All pigs must have a GA Bred tag, ear notch and breeder recorded on your entry.
3. Pigs participating in this show ARE NOT REQUIRED to be entered in the State Market Hog Show. Check in for Sunday arrivals is 7:00 am until 7:45 am. Health Papers are required. All swine must be blood tested PRV and Brucellosis negative within 30 days of the show and have an official health certificate. All out-of-state swine must have a prior permit number on the health certificate.
4. At any time, if the GA Bred tag is lost or broken, contact your breeder to obtain a new tag. Please provide a written statement to Andy Royal describing the new tag number.
5. Any variation in tag or ear notch numbers will be grounds for disqualification.
6. All entries (\$40.00 per entry) must be made ONLINE through THE SHOW PORTAL, entry deadline is **OCTOBER 3rd, 2023**. Entries after this date will include a \$20 late fee per exhibitor. THERE WILL BE NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED AFTER FRIDAY OCTOBER 13th at 1:00 pm, the portal will be closed at this time.
7. We are only having weight classes, NO SHOWMANSHIP

8. Barrows and gilts will be split in market classes and shown by weight. Purebred barrows will exhibit by breed and weight if the number of entries allow. If there are not enough entries they will be placed with crossbred market barrows and shown by weight. Purebred breeding gilts will be shown by breed (Berkshire, Duroc, Hamp, York, AOB if entries allow) and by birthday. If the number of entries doesn't support a class they will show together by birthday. Commercial gilts will be shown by weight.

9. **The maximum weight for Market is 290 with a 15 pound weigh back**, weigh cards will be due **Saturday afternoon by 3:00pm** for anyone already at the show. There will be a table in the **LOWER SWINE BARN OUTSIDE OF THE OFFICE TO PICKUP WEIGH CARDS AND RETURN THEM**. These will be available Saturday morning. If you are arriving Sunday morning you can check in and receive your weigh card at that time. **ALL PUREBRED BARROWS, CROSSBRED BARROWS, COMMERCIAL GILTS AND MARKET GILTS WILL DECLARE WEIGHT** with a 15 pound weigh back. Turning cards in on time will help get weights entered.

WEIGH CARDS FOR WEIGH BACK (PUREBRED BARROWS, CROSSBRED BARROWS, COMMERCIAL GILTS AND MARKET GILTS) WILL BE DIFFERENT COLORS. If you don't remember how you entered the show a print out will be posted at the weigh card table.

Commercial Breeding Gilts have a maximum weight of 390 pounds, with a 15 pound weigh back. If you showed your Purebred Gilt during the fair you will not need to check in again, only Sunday arrivals. We are following the rules and weigh process of the fair.

10. Class premiums will be paid for 1st through 8th places in each class based on the availability of funds. Payouts for the Champions and Reserves will be decided based on the number of entries and available funds.

11. We will offer a devotion ringside Sunday morning at 8:30 am and do our best to begin the show at 9:00 am. The show will begin with Purebred Breeding Gilts, Commercial Breeding Gilts, Purebred Market Barrows, Crossbred Market Barrows, and ending the day with Crossbred Market Gilts.
